Charlottesville – The Charlottesville Symphony returns to The Paramount Theater's stage on Saturday, June 1 at 7:30PM for *Pops at The Paramount – The Harry Potter Concert*.

Music Director Benjamin Rous leads the full symphony orchestra in music from all eight films: *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone*, *Chamber of Secrets*, *Goblet of Fire*, *Order of the Phoenix*, *Half-Blood Prince*, *Prisoner of Azkaban*, and *Deathly Hallows, Parts 1 and 2*. (Films will not be screened.)

The movie scores were composed by legendary John Williams (3), Patrick Doyle (1), Nicholas Hooper (2) and Alexandre Desplat (2). Williams is also the creator of "Hedwig's Theme," heard in all eight.

Audience members are invited to come dressed as their favorite Harry Potter-themed witch or wizard.
